Purpose of Processing

Personal data are processed exclusively for academic and organizational purposes, including:

- Submission, peer review, and scientific evaluation of abstracts
- Communication with the submitting author
- Organization of the scientific program
- Publication of accepted abstracts in conference materials

Legal Basis for Processing

Processing is based on:

- Article 6(1)(b) GDPR – performance of a contract (conference participation)
- Article 6(1)(e) GDPR – task carried out in the public interest (academic dissemination)
- Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interest in organizing an academic conference

Abstract Review and Access

Access is limited to the Scientific Committee, authorized organizers, and technical service providers acting as data processors.

Publication of Abstracts

Accepted abstracts may be published with author names and affiliations in the conference program, proceedings, and website, including the ISMeC group website (ismecgroup.org) in the “ISMEC Acta” series.

Data Retention

Abstract-related data will be retained for up to 5 years after the conference unless a longer period is required by law.

Data Subject Rights

Data subjects have the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict, or object to processing and to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

Data Security

Appropriate technical and organizational measures are implemented to protect personal data.
